#### **Exclusions and Limitations of Benefits**

- 1. Dental conditions arising out of and due to member's employment or for which Workers' Compensation is payable.
- 2. Services, which in the opinion of the Plan, are not necessary for the patient's dental health, or have a poor prognosis.
- 3. Elective or cosmetic dental care.
- 4. Oral Surgery requiring the setting of fractures or dislocations.
- 5. Treatment of malignancies, cysts, or neoplasms.
- 6. Dispensing of drugs not normally supplied in a dental office.
- 7. In the event the patient desires to be hospitalized for any dental procedure, cost will be borne by the patient.
- 8. Loss or theft of dentures or bridgework.
- 9. Any procedure of implantation, Temporomandibular Joint (T.M.J.), or full mouth reconstruction.
- 10. General anesthesia and services of a special anesthesiologist except when medically necessary for extractions. General anesthesia is not considered medically necessary for the sole purpose of alleviation of apprehension, nervousness, anxiety or fear.
- 11. Services that cannot be performed because of the general health of the patient.
- 12. Treatment required by reason of war.
- 13. Services which are provided by anyone not specifically authorized by this Plan.
- 14. Dental expenses incurred in connection with any dental procedure started after termination of eligibility for coverage, or before coverage began.
- 15. Any service that is not specifically listed as a covered expense.
- 16. Porcelain or porcelain with metal crowns/pontics on molars.
- 17. Procedures not listed as a covered benefit.
- 18. Prophylaxis is limited to two in any 12 consecutive months.
- 19. Denture relines are limited to one per arch per 12 consecutive months.
- 20. Five periodontal treatments (per quadrant) during any 12 consecutive months.
- 21. Bitewing x-rays are limited to not more than two series of four films in any twelve (12) consecutive month period.
- 22. Full mouth x-rays are limited to one set every 12 consecutive months.
- 23. Fluoride treatments once a year to age 18.
- 24. Precious metal for all crowns, removable or fixed appliances, precision partials, overlays, implants, personalization and characterizations are optional services. Member shall be responsible for payment.
- 25. Provider may refuse treatment to patient who continually fails to follow a prescribed course of treatment.
- 26. Fixed bridgework will be covered only when the use of a partial would be considered detrimental to the occlusion, causing harm to the teeth or the periodontal condition.
